Access and borrowing

The library is only accessible to current fellows, members, students, and staff of ACN.

Fellows, members and students are issued with a card, which they must present in order to access the library and borrow books. They are entitled to borrow six items for a period of two weeks for members and one week for undergraduate members with renewals. A longer loan period is available to those living at a distance to allow for postage. You are also able to view DVDs and CD ROMs in the library.

Books can be mailed to ACN fellows, members and students. Return postage or other delivery is the responsibility of the recipient.

Renewals are available by contacting library staff before the due date. Login to the catalogue – Liberty – will also allow self-service renewals and reservations. Extensions are not permitted if a reservation has been placed by another user.

Contact library staff to check the availability of a title or to make a reservation. The journal collection is not for loan.

Photocopying, printing and scanning

Photocopying, printing and scanning facilities are available in the library for a small fee. There is no charge for scanning. Library staff are able to scan or copy (within copyright limits) articles and book chapters on behalf of members and students who are unable to make a personal visit. A document delivery fee applies to each item.

Online access

Library access for students is available directly via CNnect. Click on the "Library" link after login.

Library catalogue

Books, DVDs and other items held in the library are all accessed through the catalogue - Liberty. An author, title, keyword or subject may be entered at the first enquiry screen. Many individual conference papers and book chapters are also listed in the catalogue for easier access to detailed contents. The catalogue also indexes websites and will link directly to the site by clicking on the appropriate link.

Computer literature searches

This service is available for a fee to those users requiring current or retrospective searches of databases in medicine, nursing, pharmacology, social sciences and other specialty areas. When possible, adequate notice should be given to library staff. If a user would like personal guidance in database searching it is recommended that a prior appointment be made. Guidance can also be provided by phone.

Full-text database, e-journal and e-book access

EBSCO collections – access via the internet to a wide range of full-text journals and e-books.

EBSCO allows direct linking to thousands of full-text articles available as part of the EBSCO online journal collection. Access e-journals from CINAHL, Medline, Psychology & Behavioral Sciences and Health Business Elite. Nursing Reference Center is also available. Full-text items can be printed or emailed.



Informit Health Collection includes Australian online research articles, reports and case studies of practical support to anyone studying or working in therapeutic, diagnostic and preventative health roles.



The Joanna Briggs Institute EBP Database contains an online collection of evidence-based resources and tools designed to assist in the clinical decision making process and to support best practice. Resources include systematic reviews and protocols, recommended practices, best practices information sheets, consumer information sheets, and evidence summaries.
