

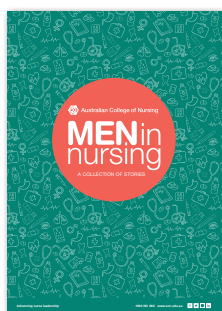

ACN would like to thank all the Working Party Members for the valued contribution over the last three years since their formation in 2018 and share with you the four major pieces of work they have produced!

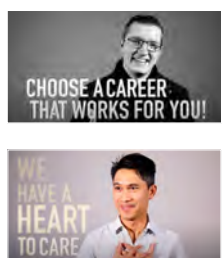

Each journey into the nursing profession takes a unique path. This was certainly the case for the 28 men who shared their personal experiences in the nursing profession with raw honesty and conviction.

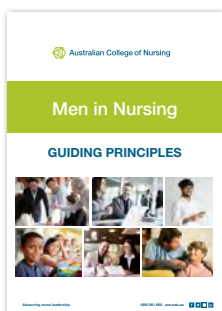

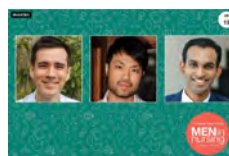
Men in Nursing Guiding Principles

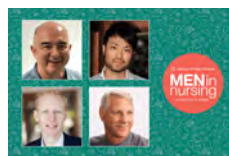

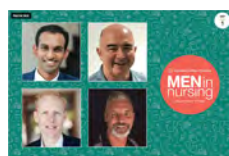
